Resources and Updates:

Energy Assistance:

The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is currently taking applications. The last day to apply for oil is April 1, 2025 and for other utilities the last day to establish eligibility for benefits is May 30, 2025. Community Renewal Team (CRT) may be able to assist you with your home-heating costs! Contact CRT to schedule an in-person appointment at (860) 560-5800. Connecticut Utility Program for Customers:

Bill discounts and a Matching Payment Program (MPP) are available to income-eligible customers. **Eversource** has implemented a new discount rate for electric customers with a financial hardship status. Customers may be eligible for a 10% or 50% discount off their electric bill per month. The Matching Payment Program (MPP) can lower the amount you owe on energy bills. Food Pantry:

West Hartford maintains a large, well-stocked food pantry of non-perishable food items. Residents are eligible to use the food pantry once a month. In order to use the Food Pantry, residents need to provide a photo ID and a recent utility bill or official piece of mail showing a West Hartford address at each visit. Income guidelines apply and are subject to change. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP):

Transportation:

West Hartford Dial-A-Ride offers transportation to medical appointments in and outside of West Hartford. They also provide rides to the grocery stores and senior centers. There is an application and a \$65 annual membership fee. To qualify, you must be aged 60 y/o or older OR be over 18 y/o and permanently disabled. Any person under 60 years of age seeking membership is required to furnish a physician's statement indicating the nature of the disability and their inability to use public transportation. Access Health CT- CT's Official Health Insurance Marketplace:

Access Health CT is Connecticut's official health insurance marketplace, where you can shop, compare and enroll in quality health and dental plans. It is also the only place where you can qualify for financial help to lower your costs, and if eligible, enroll in low or no-cost coverage through HUSKY Health Programs (Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)) or the Covered CT Program. The Housing Rehabilitation Program provides financial and technical assistance to eligible West Hartford homeowners to reduce lead hazards, correct housing code violations and remove architectural barriers that restrict the mobility and accessibility of handicapped household members. Tax Relief Programs:

The State of Connecticut requires municipalities to provide qualifying property (real or motor vehicle) owners who are totally disabled a \$1,000-property tax exemption (an amount off the property assessment). To apply for this benefit, file with the Assessment Office by January 31st. West Hartford provides additional tax exemption for veterans, elderly and totally disabled individuals annually.
